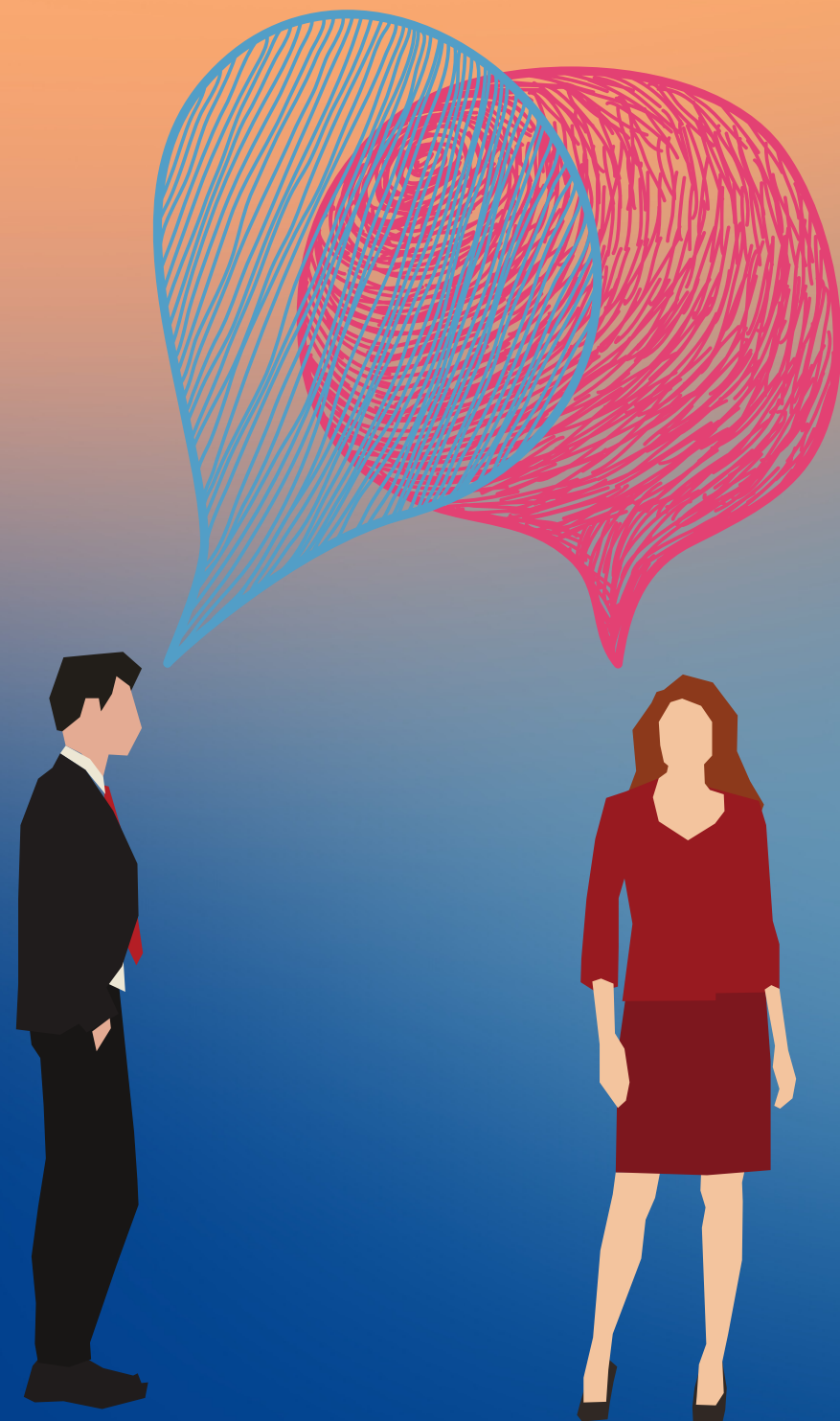

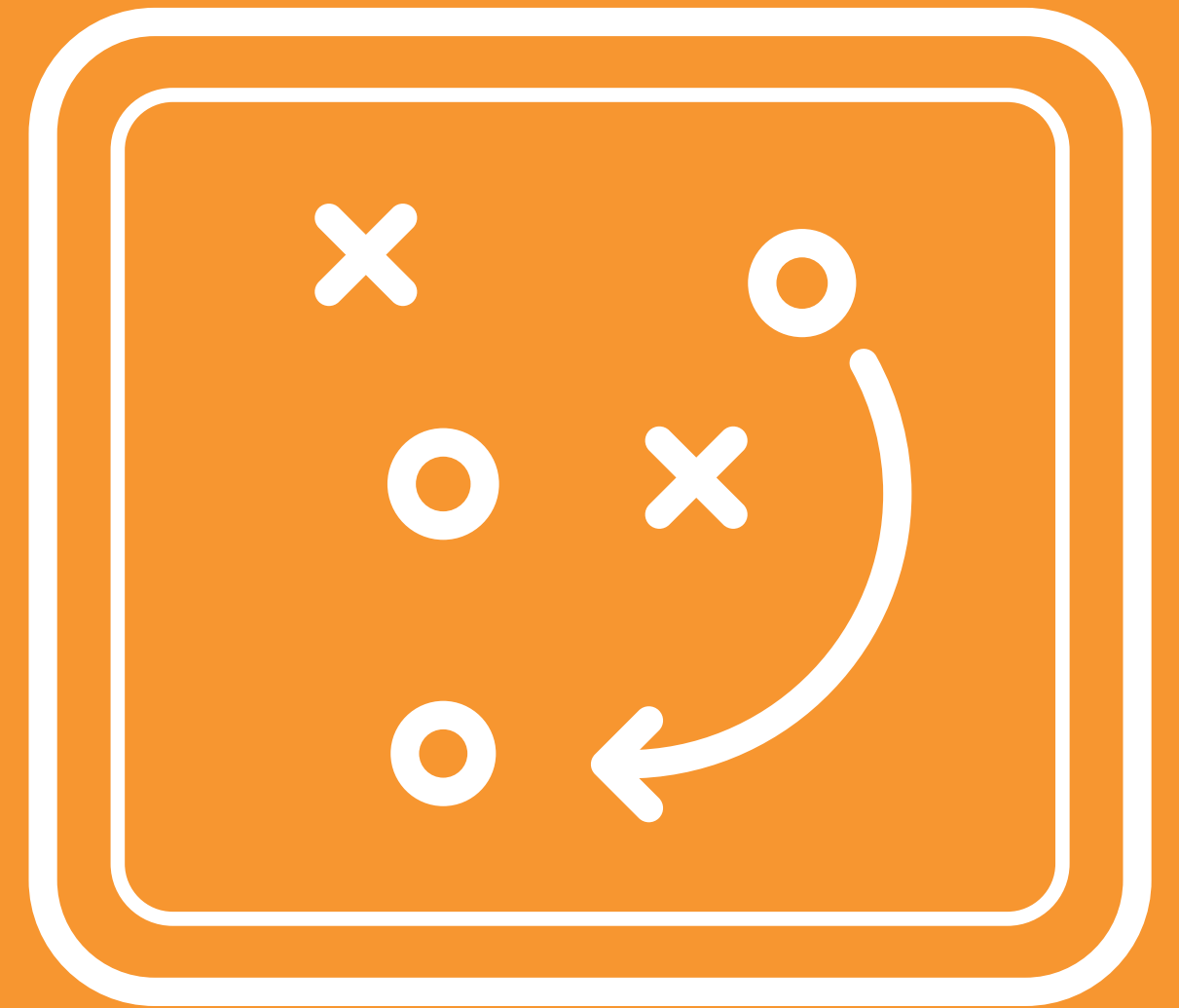

CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The College/Career Indicator measures how well local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools are preparing students for likely success after graduation. Only graduates can be classified as Prepared or Approaching Prepared. For schools and LEAs to demonstrate success on this state indicator, high school graduates must meet at least one of the measures in the prepared level.

- Complete a-g course requirements with a grade of C- or better

Dual Enrollment



- One Semester/two quarters of Dual Enrollment (2+ units) with a grade of C- or better in the academics/CTE subjects

Advanced Placement



- Score of 3 or higher on **one** AP exam
OR
• Score of 4 on **one** IB Exam

SBAC



- Level 3 or higher on ELA **and** at least a Level 2 "Standard Nearly Met" in Math
OR
• Level 3 or higher on Math **and** at least a level 2 in ELA

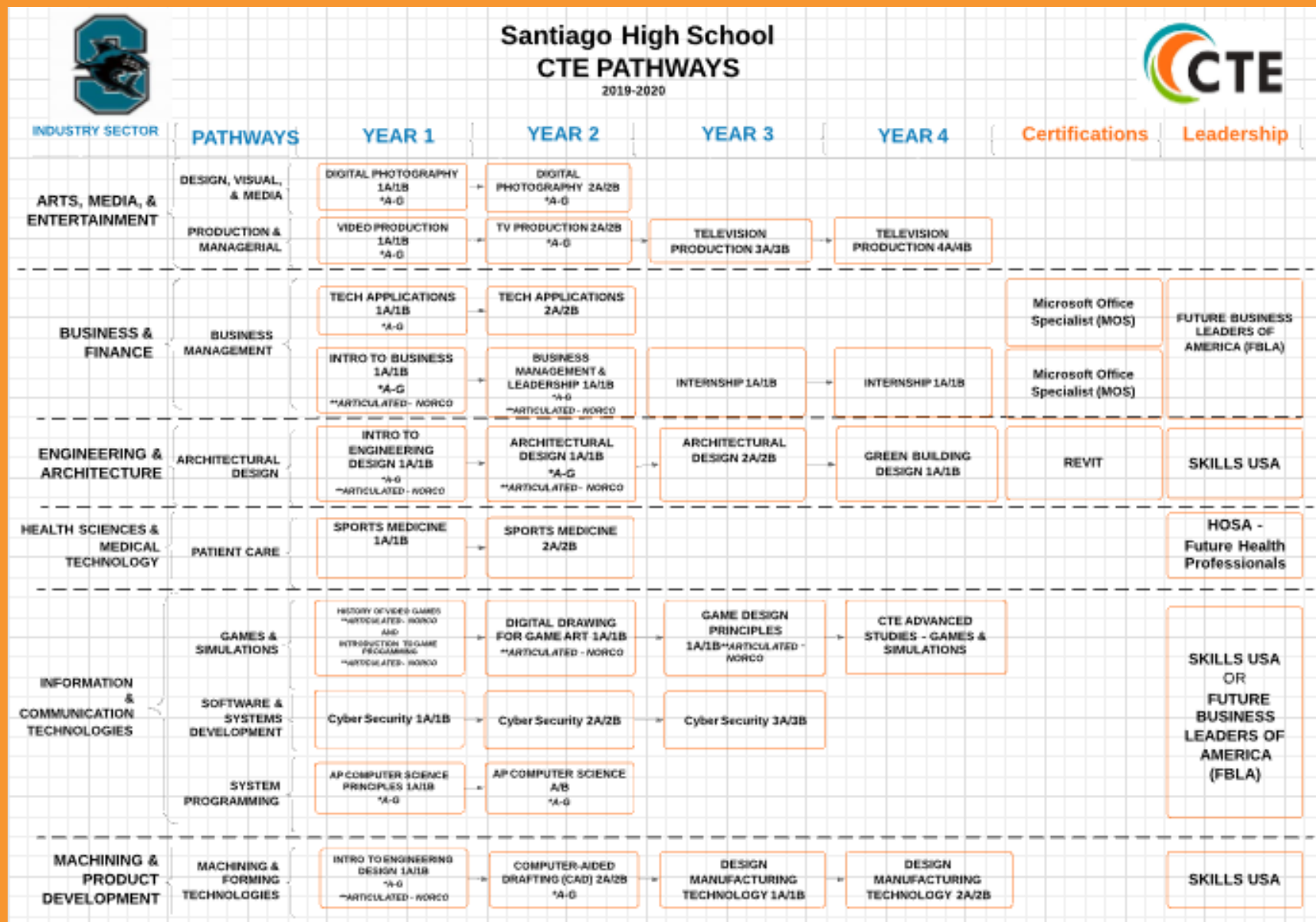

FINDINGS

- Lack of CTE Completers
- Lack of awareness of the College & Career Indicator (CCI)
- Need to review transcripts
- Need to be more intentional for students to be more prepared (placement)
 - Don't place students in random courses

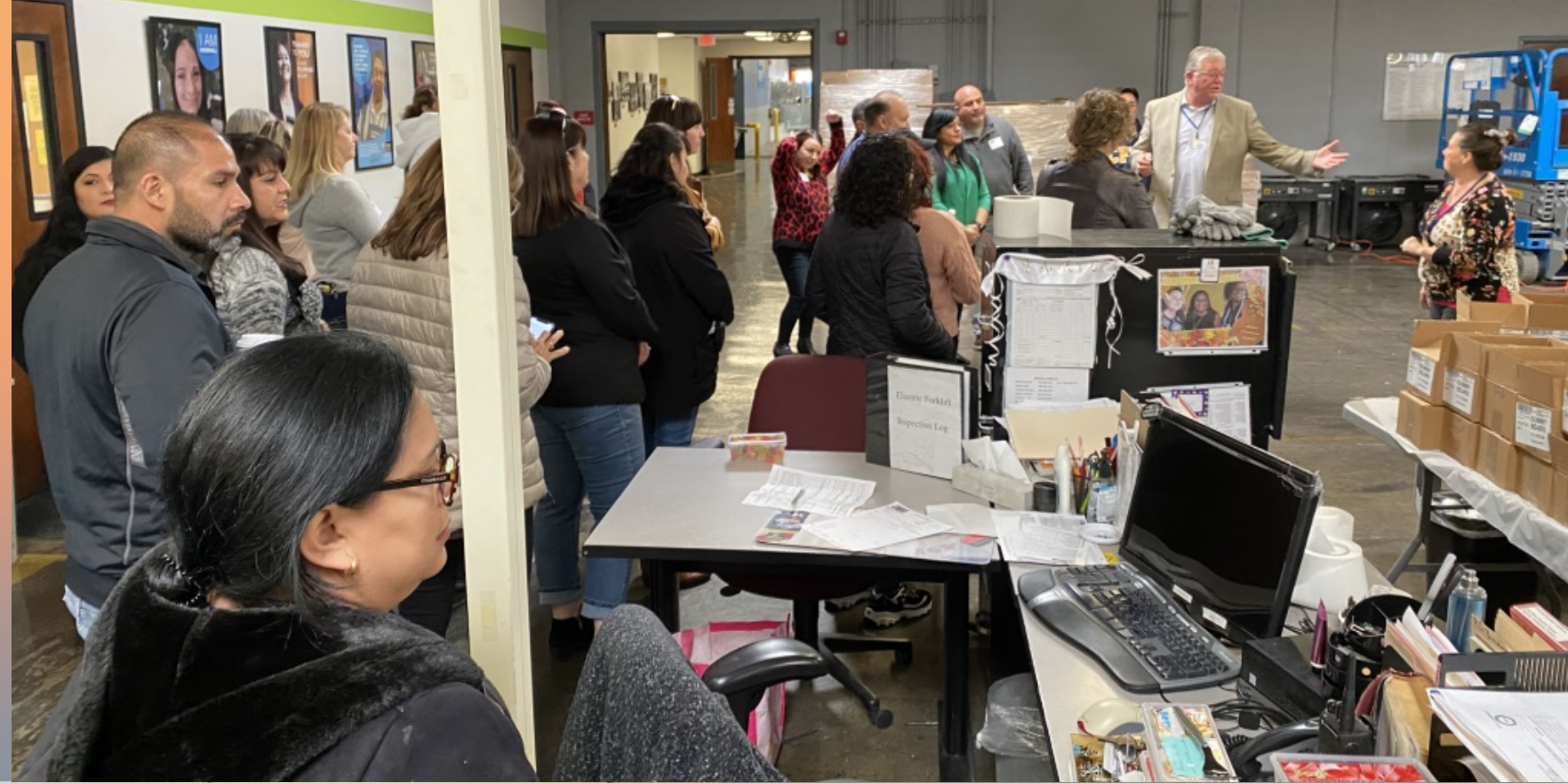
