Integration

COMMON APP AND NAVIANCE

Students can:

- Automatically sync their college lists on the Common App and Family Connection
- Request transcripts, counselor evaluations, and teacher letters of recommendation for Common App colleges from Family Connection
- Indicate that they intend to apply to a college with the Common App

Counselors & Teachers can:

- Send all supporting documents (transcripts, forms, letters of recommendation, etc.) directly to Common App colleges from within Naviance
- Complete all steps involved in processing Common App applications in Naviance (e.g. process Common App Early Decision Agreements)

For many applicants and their families, the most daunting aspect of the journey to college is the price tag.



The Federal Government:

From federal grants, to federal student loans, to employment through the federal work-study program, The U.S. Department of Education awards about \$150 billion a year to more than 15 million students. Visit the **Office of Federal Student Aid** to learn more.



Your State Government:

Similar to the federal government, your home state offers various types of financial aid, and guess what? You might be eligible for this type of aid even if you're not eligible for federal aid. For more information, contact your **state grant agency**.

- Initiative of the Michael & Susan Dell Foundation designed to connect students with scholarships
- Lets students apply for a scholarship online and then re-use that information for other scholarship applications
- Approached Common App for assistance in connecting with students
- Project aligns with our goal of expanding financial aid awareness

FAFSA AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

- Conducted in partnership with a team of researchers led by Dr. Ben Castleman at the University of Virginia
- Personalized information and behavioral nudges about college affordability, financial aid, and FAFSA completion
- Coordinated effort among multiple partners
- Targeted 450,000 low-income and first-generation applicants



STRIVE VIRTUAL MENTORING

- Not-for-profit virtual mentoring program
- Offers additional support for low-income, first-generation students
- Common App connects students who indicate a need for a fee waiver with Strive
- Mentors can help students navigate the college application process, fill out FAFSA documents, and find scholarships




