





## Activity #1—GPA Team Race



What can I do to be an UPSTANDER?

- 1. Emotional/Psychological
- 2. Cyber
- 3. Physical
- 4. Verbal



- · Fill out an incident report
- · Befriend the target
- · AVOID VIOLENCE!
- If you feel safe, stand up for the person being bullied
- · Tell an adult





#### What if I am the target?

- Stay in a group
- Participate in school activities to meet friends with similar interests
- AVOID VIOLENCE!
- · If you are being bullied online, DON'T REPLY!
- · If you feel safe, tell the bully, "STOP! I don't like that!"





# Bully Zones/Bully Free Zones






# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Anti-Bully Lesson
