

Priority #1 - Curriculum & Instruction

Our students will demonstrate academic growth and the proficiencies needed to meet their post K-12 goals

- 1. There will be an increase in the percent of TVUSD students who qualify, are admitted, and prepared to succeed in a college program.
- 2. There will be an increase in the percent of TVUSD students who are prepared to enter the workforce upon graduation.
- 3. There will be an increase in the percent of students who demonstrate proficiency or higher for all district, state, and federal performance standards.
- 4. Survey data will indicate that parents and students believe that the programs in TVUSD have prepared them for their post K-12 goals.

- → Increase A-G completion

 - Course offering
 - Grading restructuring
 - Quality 1st
 Instruction Targeted
 interventions/support
- Disseminate the key strategies and implementation of best practices to site administration, PLCs, and within department meetings
- → Review end of year result data
- → Identify a new challenge
- → Begin the process again!!

Creating a College going Culture

- → Utilizing data to promote course of rigor:
 - AP Readiness Data: Targeted individualized invitations
- → 6th 12th Grade:
 - Clear messaging through CCGI lessons and presentations
- → Annual individualized student audits
- → Multi-Platform parent information

Utilization of Outside Resources

- Promoting the link between Khan Academy and College Board to strengthen learning
- → CalSOAP Success Coaches:
 - Individualized student focus meetings and data driven follow-up

Restructured Grading and Support

- Strategic Math Pathways
 - Utilizing assessment data
 - Collaborative team approach
- → Co-Teaching Math Concepts
 - Math credentialed teacher to ensure SpEd and Math needs are sufficiently met
- → Removal of the "D" grade
- Intervention embedded in ALL student schedules

Menu of Credit Recovery & A-G Course Offerings

- A-G summer school
- APEX: A-G credit recovery options
- Asynchronous flex period options (visual on next slide)
- Alternative course offerings outside of TVUSD
- → A-G CTE courses = Career Ready






