

Middle School Counselors' Re-Entry: Strategies for Returning to Campus

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Q: Where can we reference this data about students struggling pre-pandemic compared to now?

A: You can reference this data through the National Education Association.

Q: How have COVID-19 transmissions been in school since the reopening?

A: Transmission in schools have NOT been a critical issue here in the South Florida area. IMPORTANT PHRASE: Inform, Practice, & Enforce...

Q: Can you share about the daily SEL structure, you mentioned you had it, then took it away, now its back. Is it rolled out to students during a homeroom or during a specific class period?

A: Some School Counselors do meetings the first fifteen minutes of the day and others do them before or after third period. It depends on your schedule and on instruction schedules. Having the teacher's support also helps. Morning meetings/circles can be an effective way to start back in the classroom. Establishing those norms/procedures is key.
