# Did you know?

- By 2025 (the year our 6th graders graduate from high school),
   65% of the jobs in CA will require a Bachelor's Degree or higher. (Public Policy Institute of CA)
- At the current rate of degree attainment, CA will fall short of meeting this need by 5.6% or 1.1 million degrees
   CA currently ranks 40th in the country for college-going rate

# Why College and Career Readiness Matters to the Inland Empire



The Inland Empire has the **lowest college-going rate** of any major population area of the state (only the San Joaquin Valley and the farthest north-eastern counties of the state are lower).



# Why What We Do Matters to Our Students

The Inland Empire has the lowest percentage of households where someone has at least some college experience.

That means it is more likely that our students will not have someone in their home who has experience *navigating* the college exploration, application, enrollment and success process.

We reviewed and discussed our District LCAP Goals with the leadership team.

Each Team was composed of about 12-13 members.









# Every Thursday 2 Hour Late Start









#### A-G Requirements



Non AVID Students were able to create a college pennant to be displayed in our College Gallery walk!






