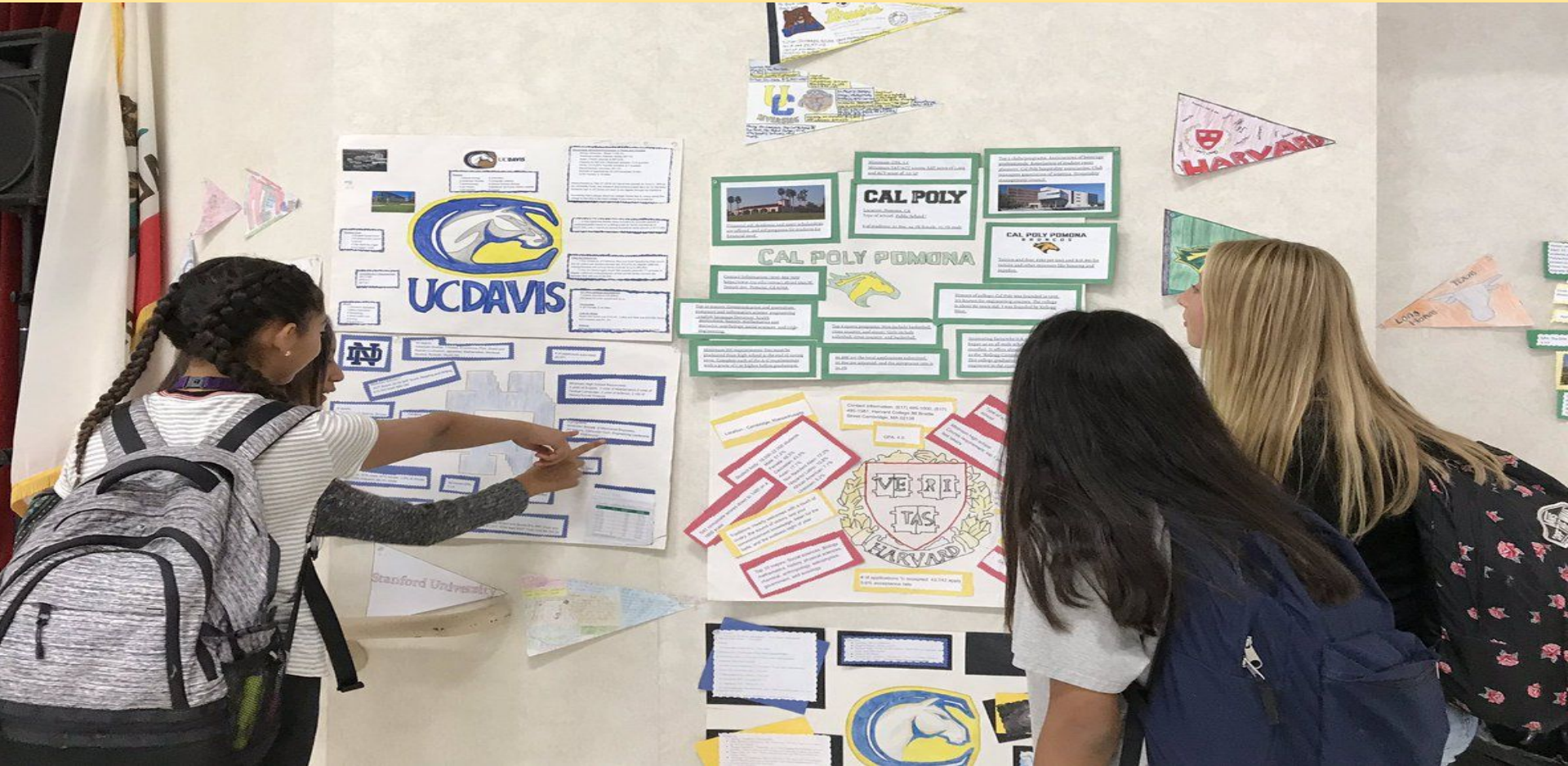
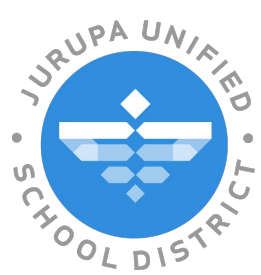

Did you know?

- By 2025 (the year our 6th graders graduate from high school), **65% of the jobs** in CA will require a Bachelor's Degree or higher. (Public Policy Institute of CA)
- At the current rate of degree attainment, CA will fall short of meeting this need by 5.6% or **1.1 million** degrees
CA currently ranks **40th in the country** for college-going rate

Why College and Career Readiness Matters to the Inland Empire



The Inland Empire has the **lowest college-going rate** of any major population area of the state (only the San Joaquin Valley and the farthest north-eastern counties of the state are lower).





Why What We Do Matters to Our Students

The Inland Empire has the lowest percentage of households where someone has at least *some* college experience.

That means it is more likely that our students will not have someone in their home who has experience *navigating* the college exploration, application, enrollment and success process.

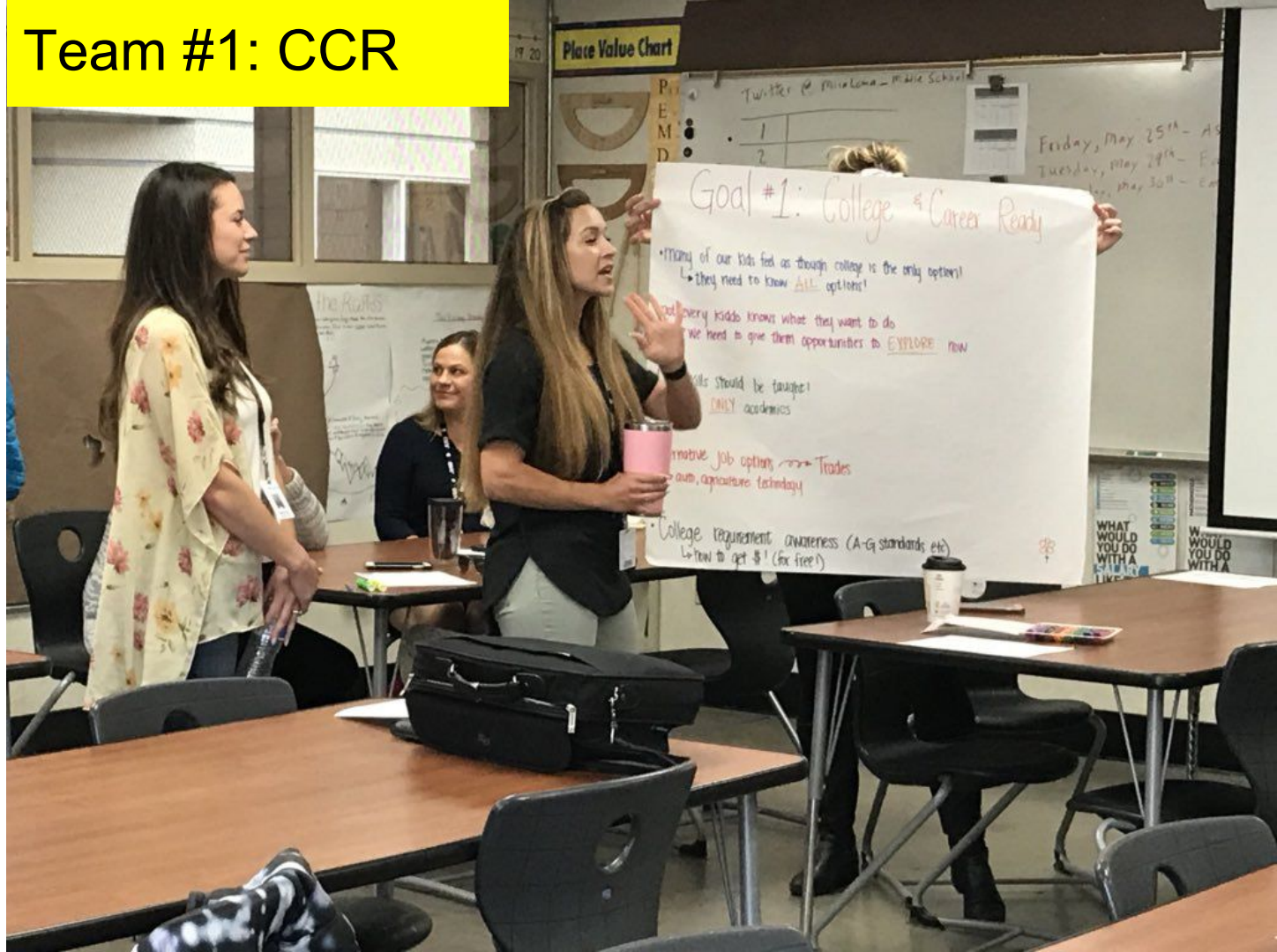

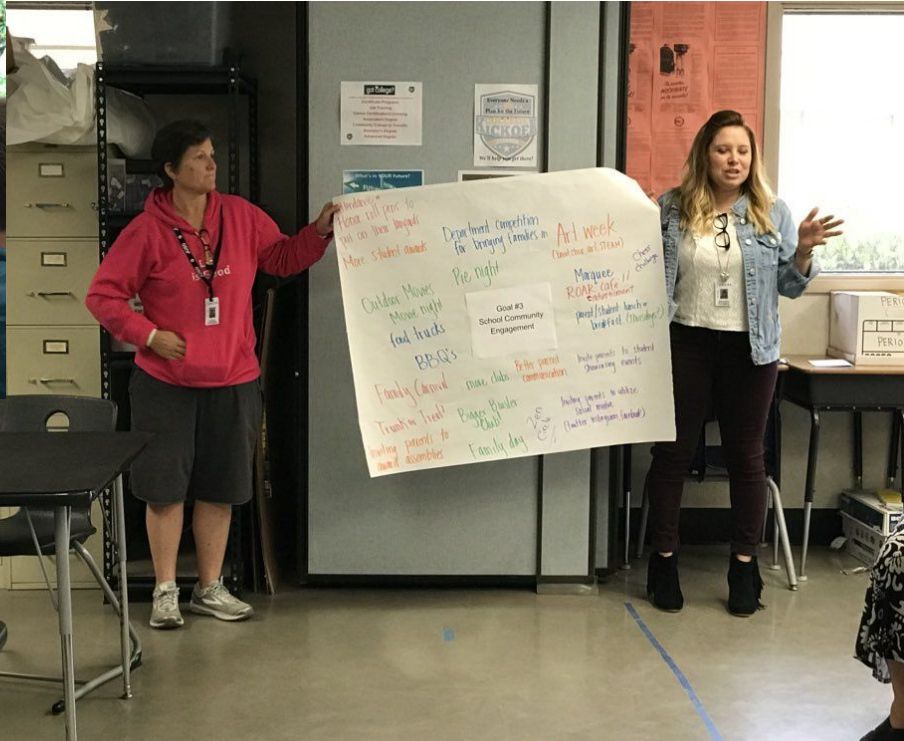

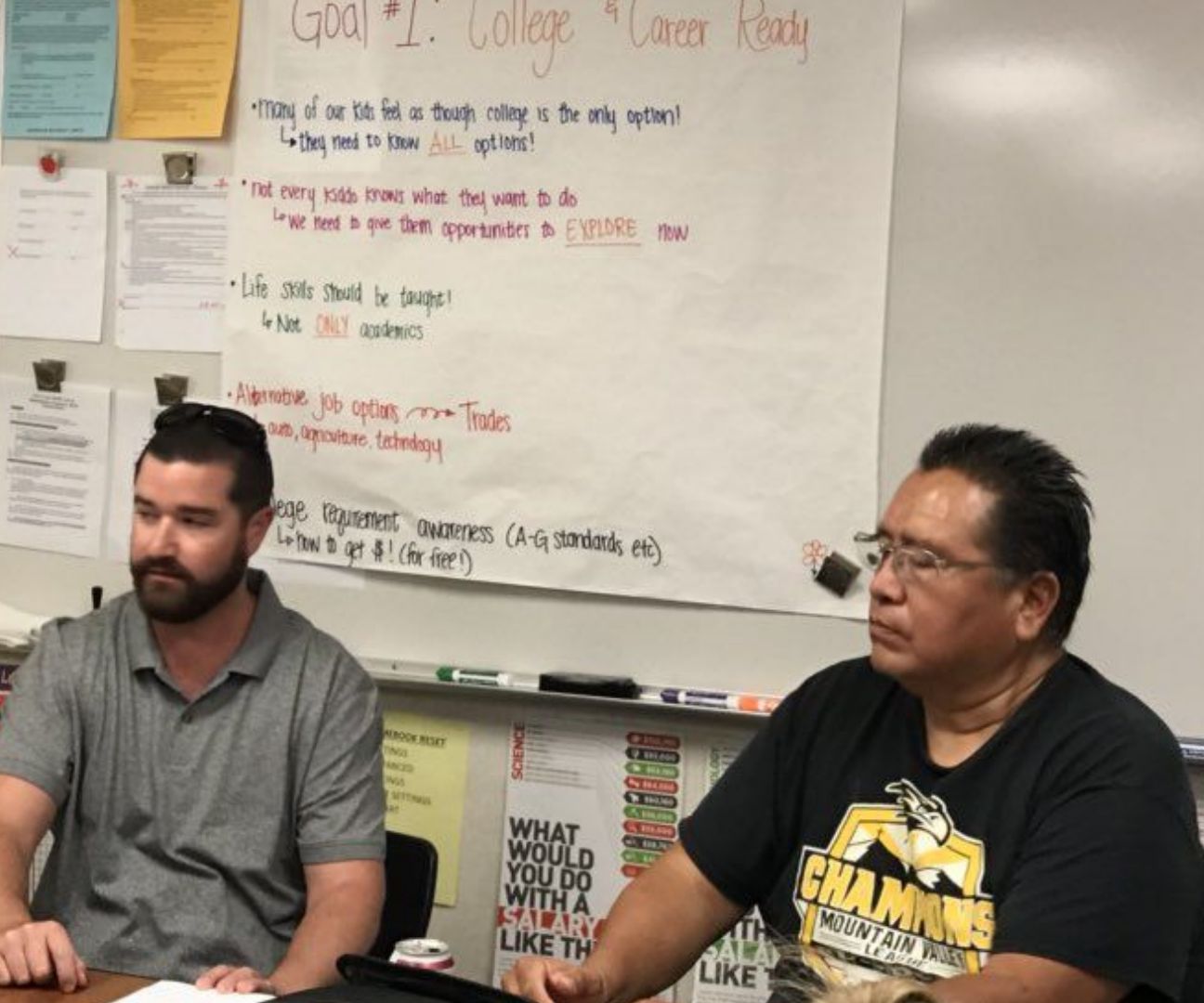

C	Mathematics 3 years required, UC-4 recommended	
D	Lab Science 2 years required, UC-3 recommended	
E	Foreign Language 2 years, UC-3 recommended	
F	Visual & Performing Arts 1 year required	
G	College Preparatory Electives 1 year required

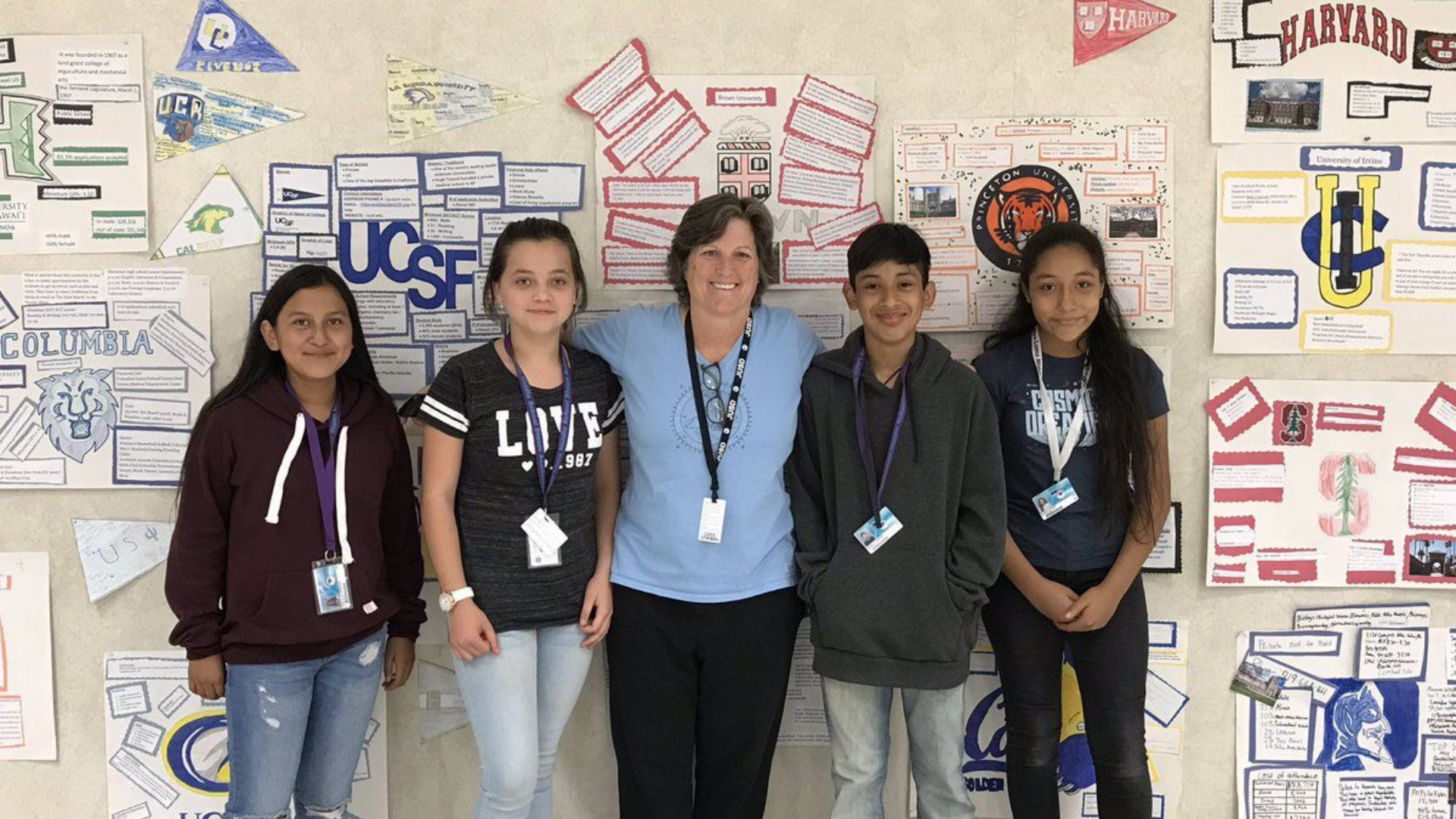

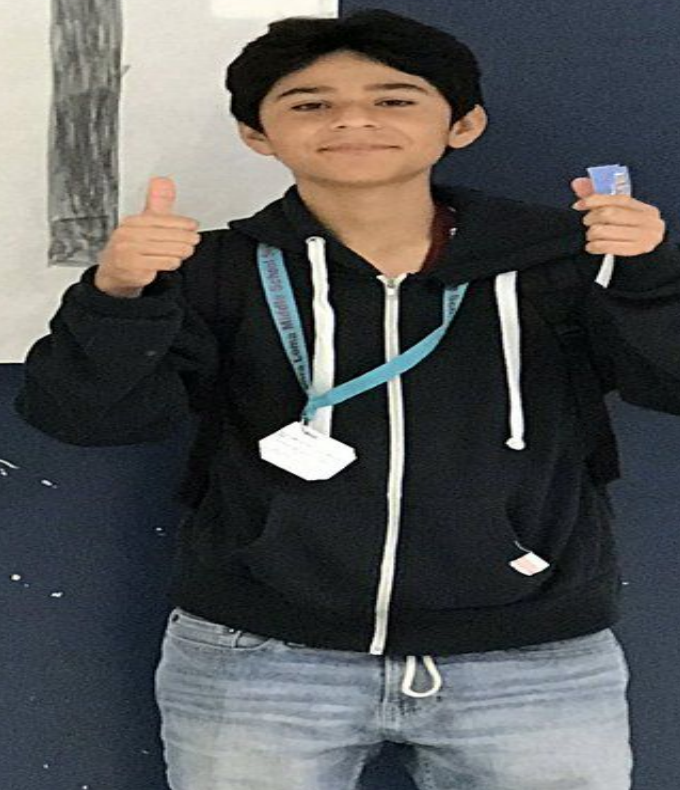
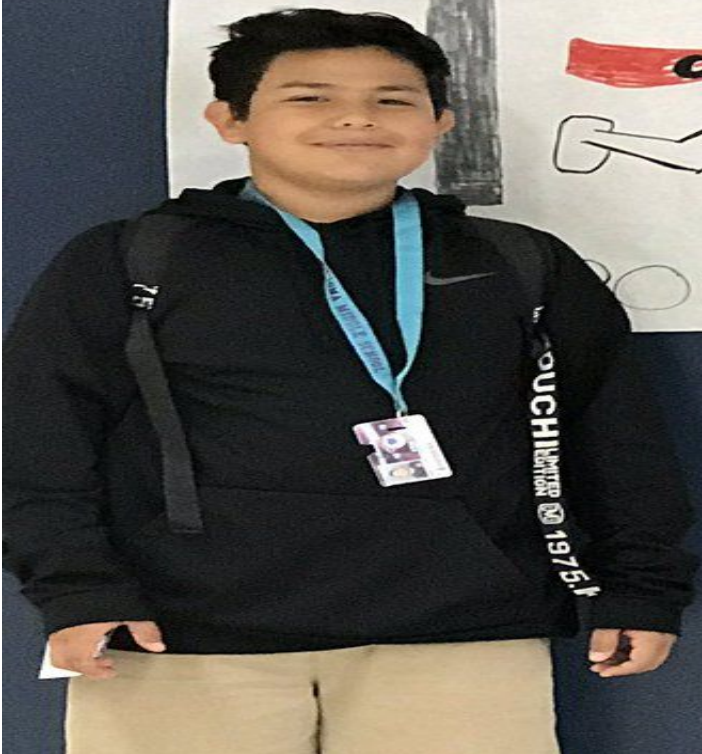

Partnership for Access to College Education (PACE)

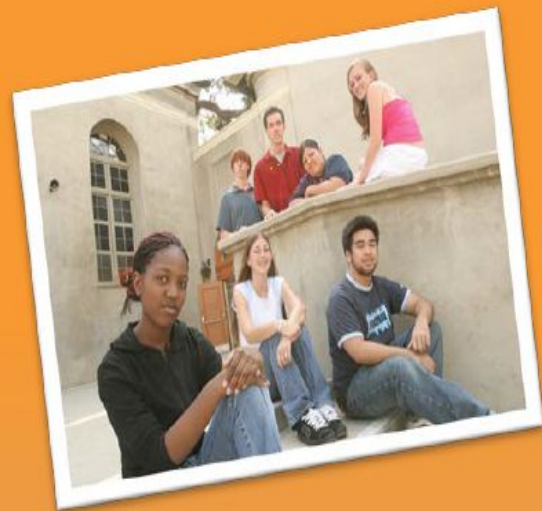

- Guaranteed admission for meeting GPA and SAT/ACT thresholds as set by the University of La Verne
- A minimum \$10,000 annual academic scholarship for up to four years of undergraduate study
- Application fee waiver

- MOU with Jurupa Unified School District

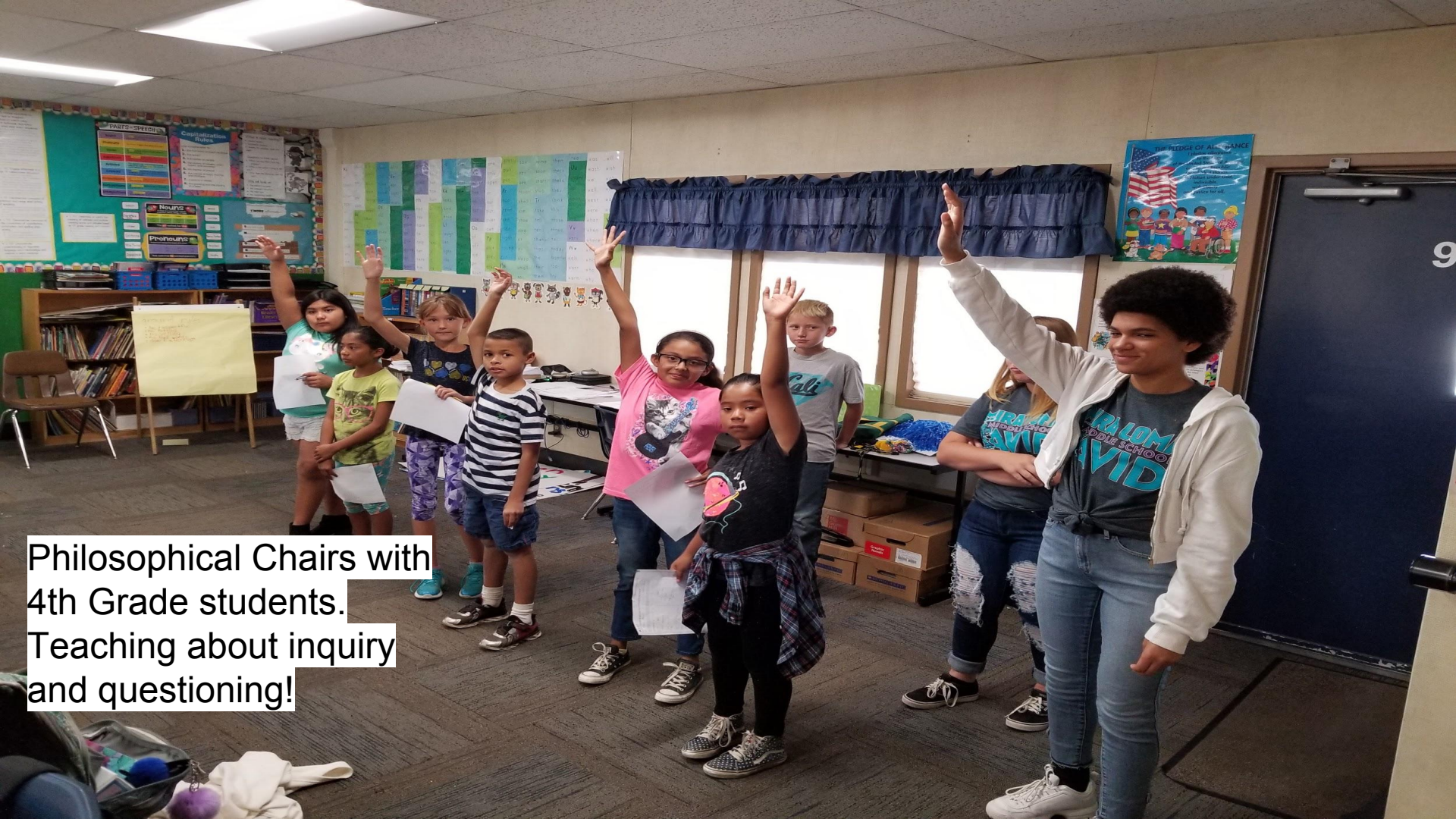
Students will come to RCC with up to 30 units of college credit - just beginning this partnership with local feeder high schools.
