

Meeting Early Decision and Freshman Requirements

Use the chart below to determine what is required to gain eligibility as a high school student. GED, HiSet and home school requirements are also shown.

After completion of junior year

GPA of 3.0+*
&
ACT 18+* or SAT 970+****

If not met...

After completion of 7 semesters

GPA of 2.5+*
&
ACT 18+* or SAT 970+****

If not met...

After graduation

GPA of 2.0+*
ACT 18+* or SAT 970+**
Top 50% Class Rank**

Home School Students

**Completion of home school program
(Must submit final transcript with graduation date)**

ACT 20+* or SAT 1040+**

GED/HiSet Students

**Completion of GED/HiSet
(Must submit official GED/HiSet records)**

ACT 18+* or SAT 970+**

*EXCEPTION: ACT tests taken March 1, 2016 through April 30, 2019 require a composite score of 16. ACT test taken during this time by home school students require a composite score of 18.

**EXCEPTION: SAT tests taken March 1, 2016 through April 30, 2019 require a score of 860. SAT test taken during this time by home school students require a score of 950.

***GPA requirements are based on 4.00 scale
