Why Reach Higher?

- Access to information about college depends on <u>school resources</u>
- School resources depend on the **surrounding community**.
- 45.5% of Low-income High School Graduates enroll in postsecondary education
- An educated workforce is a stronger economy







Reach Higher Ambassadors


- Our Advisory Board (like Better Make Room)



- 5. What are the physical standards candidates have to meet?
- 6. Can an entrant choose the job he/she wants? How is the job assignment made?
- 7. Can a trainee choose to serve oversees?
- 8. How much does a new recruit get paid and what are the benefits?
- 9. What kind of training comes after basic?
- 10. What are the ways a service member can earn college credits during enlistment?
- 11. What are your tuition support programs and how does an entrant qualify for them?
- 12. How long am I required to serve?
- 13. What are the educational benefits?
- 14. Thank you for you for serving our country!

Whether you meet them at a college fair or on a campus visit, college representatives genuinely enjoy talking to high school students and answering questions about their college. The following questions will help start a good dialogue.

- 2. For what academic programs is your college known?
- 12. What's the surrounding area like? Is it easy to get around?
- 3. How would you describe the students at your college?
 Where are most of them from?
- 13. What are the most popular majors?
- 4. Where do students hang out on campus?
- 14. How would you describe the academic pressure and workload?
- What happens on weekends are there things to do on campus or in town, or do most students on home?
- 15. What support services (academic advisers, tutors, etc.) are available?
- 6. Are fraternities and sororities a big part of campus life?
- 16. Do I need to bring my own computer?
- 7. What are the housing options for freshmen?
- 17. What's the faculty like? Are they accessible outside of class?

8. Do many students live off campus?

- 18. Are there opportunities for internships?
- 9. Is there a sports complex or fitness center?
- 19. Is there job placement help for graduates?
- 10. What are the most popular clubs and activities?
- 20. Are there any big changes in the works that I should know about?


Reach Higher 10 Year Plan Signing Day




Why did we teach and implement this lesson and activities?

- Reduce the cycle of poverty


