Sort by: Time

Someone who stands observes something or someone else join the bully in saying or doing harmful things, or doing nothing which affirms the actions of the bully say something to a trusted adult or speak up to the bully to support the person being bullied.

Jennife...

Bystander: someone who observes bullying and doesn't do anything to intervene. This makes the situation worse because the victim no longer trusts that bystander. By doing nothing, the bystander has sided with the bully. A bystander can lessen the impact of bullying by intervening when they witness bullying and by showing the victim that they can be trusted to do the right thing.

Liz T M...

A bystander is someone who witnesses something unkind, yet does nothing about it. It's made worse when bystander joins in, but they can make it better by standing up for the individual being targeted.

Amy M...

Someone who sees something but does nothing

By walking away

By appropriately addressing the situation.

Luke Jo...

Someone who sees what is happening and does nothing about it. By not saying anything they are "telling" others it is an okay thing to do. They can make it better by saying something.

Tara Pe...

A bystander is someone who is a witness but does nothing to stop, bullying. They make it worse by providing an audience and apparent validation for the bullying. They can make it better by changing to an upstander or ally.

Patricia...

Someone who watches something happen, but does not do anything about it. If you see it and you don't do anything it is condoning the behavior. They can learn more about supporting bullying so they are comfortable jumping in to say something.

Stacy M...

Someone who sits back and watches. They allow it to happen and make it an ok behavior or acceptable behavior. They can stop standing BY and start standing UP.

Michael...

A bystander is the audience to the comments made.

They make it worse by giving the jerks an ear / silent encouragement.

They can make it better, by standing up for someone, debunking the myth, safety in numbers.

Risky because they can become the next target or so they think.

Judith ...

1. Someone who observes a bullying behavior but does not actively participate.  
2. They make it worse by not doing anything about it which is the same as agreeing with it.  
3. They can make it better by stepping in and stopping it or stepping in to support the target

Julie H...

Someone who is present at a situation where someone is being bullied, if a bystander sees something but doesn't take action it could make things worse. Stepping in could help

Alexan...

An observer  
By not addressing the situation  
Confronting the "bullyer" and having a productive conversation

Eric Be...

Someone who observes but doesn't interact. By not interacting when they see someone bullying, they are permitting the bullying by silently accepting it. They can make it better by saying something, confronting the bully, calling out what they are doing wrong, or telling an adult.

Daniell...

Bystander: One who watches without interacting in the situation  
Bystanders make bullying worse because their inaction is passive acceptance and approval  
They can make it better by ending the bystanding behavior and becoming an upstander (is that the term?)

Joanne ...

1. Someone who is around an event that is happening. 2. By not saying anything during the event or standing up for someone after the event. 3. By helping when they can and standing up for another person at an event.
