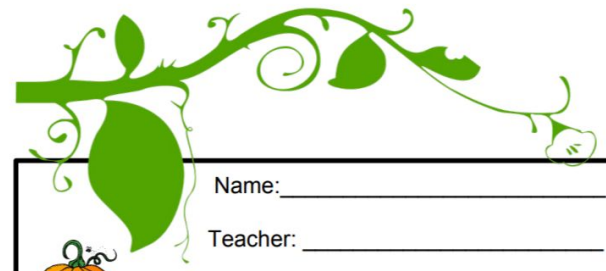
One of these activities will be our Schoolwide College & Career Project
