 - Inform parents about the topics that matter most.
 - Enable educators to track student progress.



What is CCGI?

The California College Guidance Initiative (CCGI) manages CaliforniaColleges.edu. We seek to ensure that:

- 1. All high school seniors graduate with clear postsecondary goals and a plan for how to achieve them.
- 2. Students' academic transcript data follows them as they advance across educational systems to inform key decisions about admissions, placement, guidance, and financial aid.

County-District-School Code (CDS) OR CEEB Code	Same School (in CMP)
Academic Year	Same School Year (in CMP)
Subject Area	Same Subject Area (in CMP)
 Local Courses match on one of the following two criteria: Local Course ID Transcript Abbreviation match based on CSU Abbreviation Substitution list 	Same Course ID or Transcript Abbreviation (in CMP)
