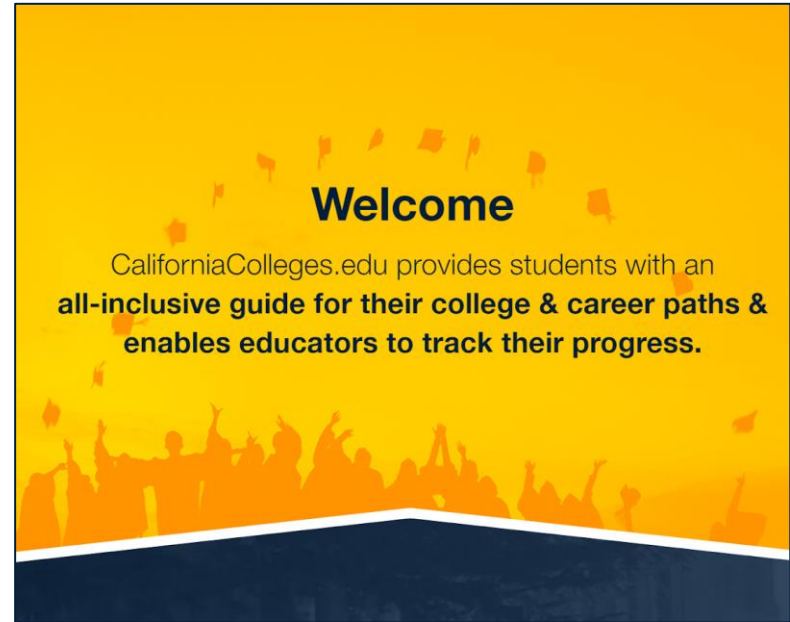

- Inform **parents** about the topics that matter most.
- Enable **educators** to track student progress.



What is CCGI?

The California College Guidance Initiative (CCGI) manages CaliforniaColleges.edu. We seek to ensure that:

1. All high school seniors graduate with **clear postsecondary goals** and a **plan** for how to achieve them.
2. Students' academic transcript data **follows them** as they advance **across educational systems** to **inform key decisions** about admissions, placement, guidance, and financial aid.

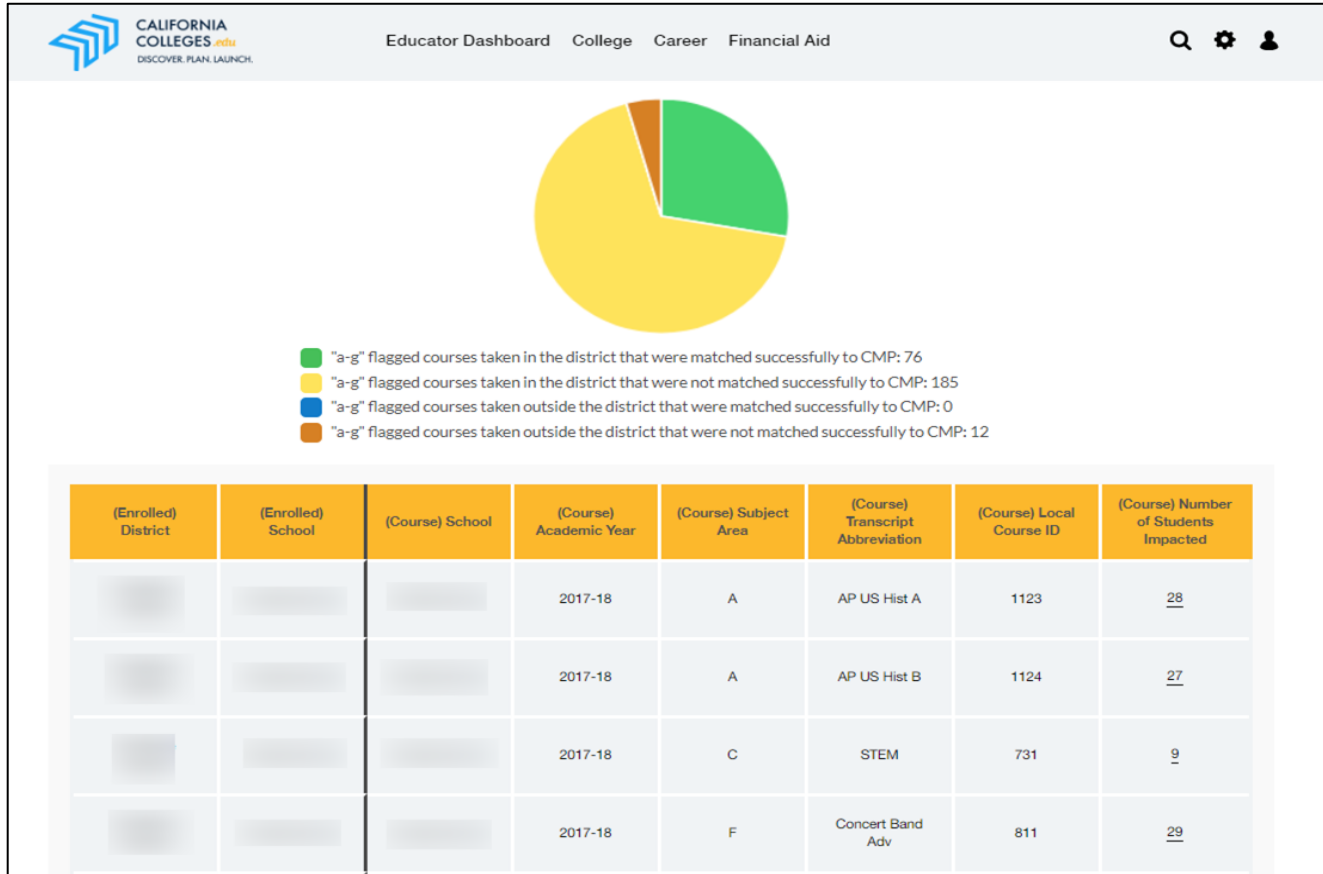

CSU and UC Eligibility Tools

In partner districts, the **CSU** and **UC Eligibility Tools** allow students to quickly track their progress toward meeting “a-g” requirements.

CSU GPA

THINGS TO KNOW

The CSU Eligibility Tool helps you track your progress toward meeting eligibility for CSU by listing required coursework on the far left and comparing it to your completed and enrolled coursework. To ensure you stay on track, use this tool to also plan for future courses that are offered at your school and help satisfy CSU requirements.

All of your coursework on the Eligibility Tool will be color-coded with each color representing something different so be sure to study the legend below carefully.

The University of California (UC) Course Management Portal (CMP) is a website where all your “a-g” courses are tracked by both the CSU and UC. Your school district enters courses into UC CMP. If you see a course in yellow on your CSU and UC Eligibility Tools, this means your school has labeled the course as “a-g”, but it is not listed in UC CMP. Talk with your counselor to learn more when you see courses in yellow.

District-created course data is verified against UCOP Course Management Portal (CMP) "a-g" course lists using CDS Code.

Students' courses are available in their My Plan / Academic Planner. Mismatched coursework visible in eligibility tools.

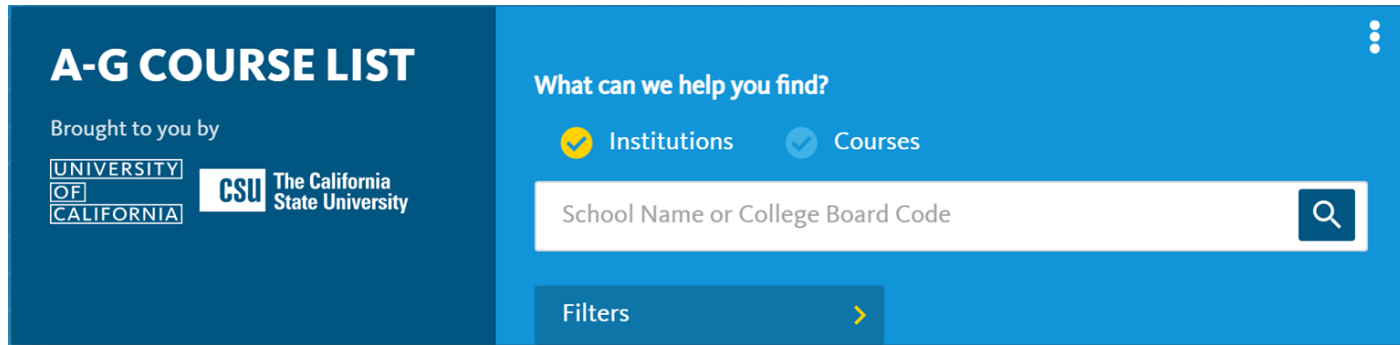
Students' course grade data is imported into their CSU application for them to review and submit.

Web Admit displays transcript entries that are transcript-verified and user-created.

Analytical data: aggregate-level information to support research and learning.

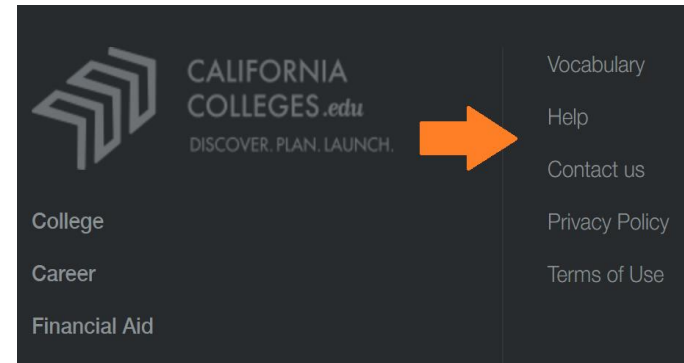


Actionable data: operational tools that directly benefit students and families.
