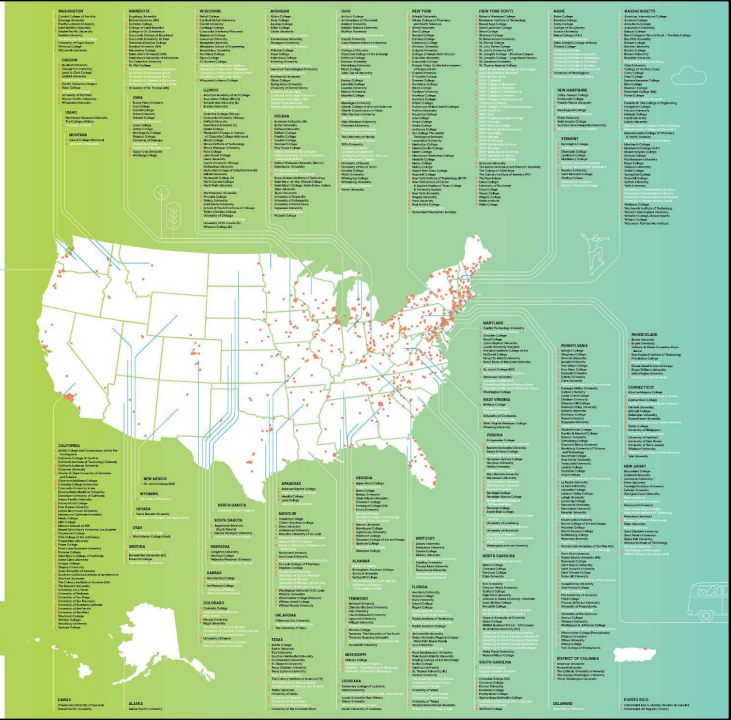

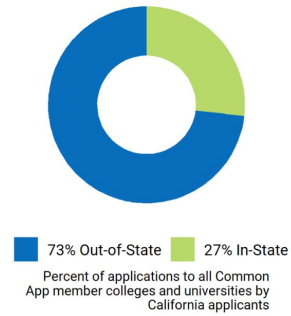

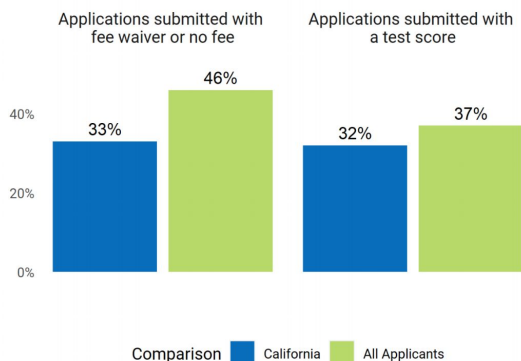

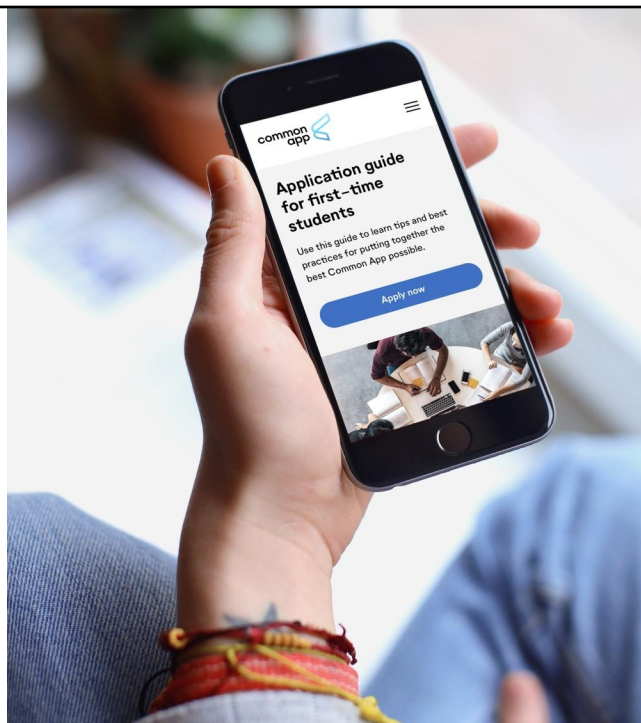
Application updates



Mobile app now available

Common App for mobile provides the same secure, streamlined application experience as the Common App online, all from the convenience of a mobile device.

The mobile app seamlessly integrates with the desktop experience – allowing students to apply to college, research financial aid, and get advice from counselors – virtually anytime, anywhere.



Evolving the Application

Evolving the App is an initiative that examines categories within the common portion of the application, as part of Common App's ongoing effort to create an inclusive application for all students.

The inaugural project ran from March 2020 - February 2021.

We will repeat this process on an annual basis.

Summary of changes

Sex and gender

- Revised questions that deal with gender identity
- Added pronouns and preferred first name
- Changed "Sex" to "Legal sex" and moved to demographics section

Family

- Revised, made optional, or removed questions that may create barriers for undocumented/ DACA students

Military discharge

- Removed the question

Citizenship

- Combined the Geography and Citizenship sections
- Revised, made optional, or removed questions that may create barriers for undocumented/ DACA students

Religious affiliation

- Removed the question

School discipline

- Removed the question

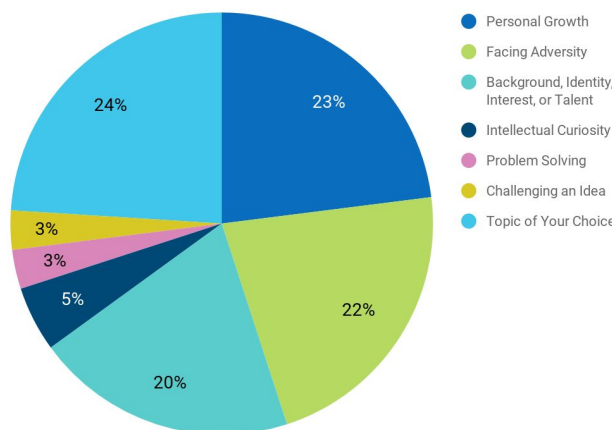
Personal essay

Beginning August 1, the Problem Solving prompt was replaced with a new prompt on Gratitude:

Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?

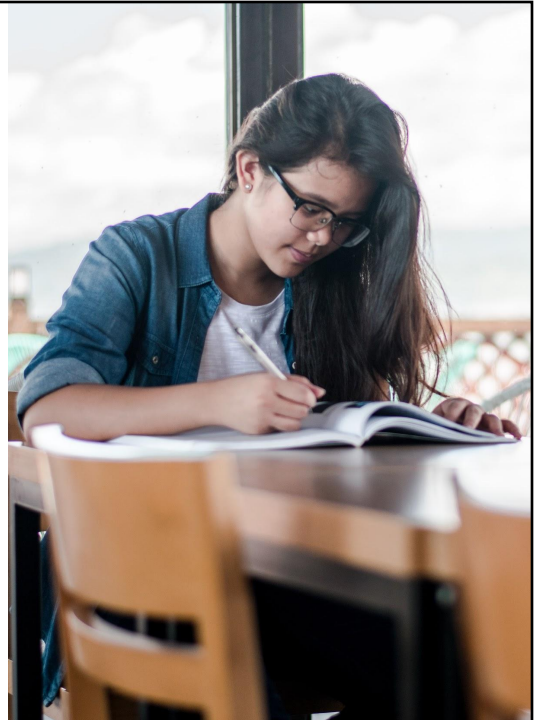
Community disruptions

Question located in the Additional Information section

Community disruptions such as COVID-19 and natural disasters can have deep and long-lasting impacts. If you need it, this space is yours to describe those impacts. Colleges care about the effects on your health and well-being, safety, family circumstances, future plans, and education, including access to reliable technology and quiet study spaces. - Optional
- 250 word limit
- Separate from the existing Additional Information question, which remains (650 word limit)
- Counselors are also asked to discuss the impact of these events on the school community in their forms

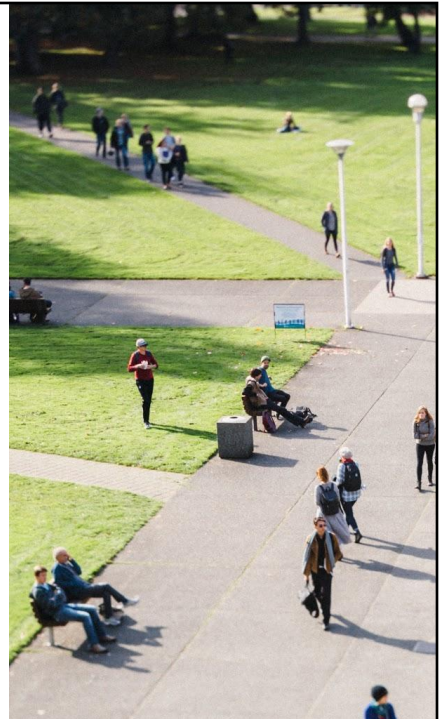

- Current Year Courses: aligned language and data points with Courses & Grades
- Courses & Grades: updated introductory language

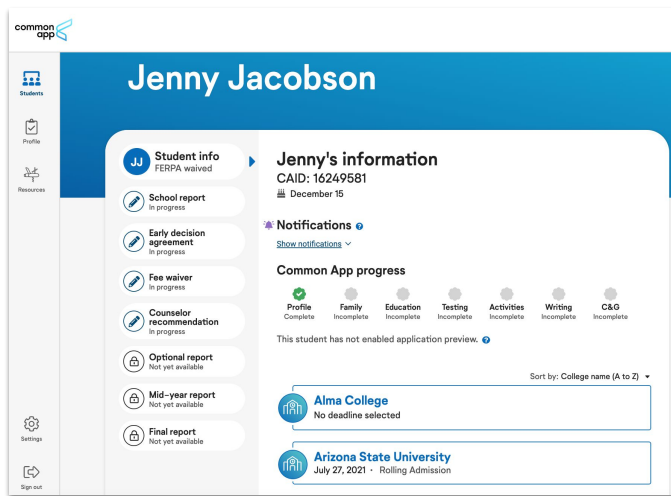


First-year recommender system

700K+ counselors, teachers, advisors, and other recommenders use the Common App to support students with the application process

- Download the Requirements Grid

- Export detailed lists to Excel

Submitting forms

Common App uses single-submission (“one-and-done”) to streamline the process for counselors, teachers, and other recommenders.

Each college determines which forms they require.

- School profile
- School report
- Early decision agreement
- Fee waiver
- Counselor recommendation (35% require)
- Optional report 1 and 2
- Mid-year report (25% require)
- Final report
- Teacher evaluation (30% require)
- Other evaluation
