











Financial Aid Assistance (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

- What do we in the College and Career Center do to help support our high school seniors? – Strategic and Intentional Support.
 - FAFSA/CADAA Application Workshops
 - Download reports from Webgrants at least once a week
 - Targeted outreach to students who have not submitted their applications to attend our scheduled workshops
 - Email blast to senior students and families, sending reminders to complete the application prior to the deadline: March 2nd 2022
 - Financial Aid Fridays (incentives for students who have completed their applications)










Tracking how many students I see on a daily basis by having them sign-in by scanning a QR code, which takes them to a Google Form.










Collaboration
















Our mission during College and Career Kickoff month (October) is to help prepare students for life after high school, whether that be college, military, or workforce.

 - Students are to answer questions regarding college and career topics for a chance to win a prize each day for a week








 - Hosting application workshops










Year-Round Presentations

 - Allows students to explore their options








Strategic and Intentional Counselor Support
