



What is it?? Tuition Reduction!!

Students in Western states may enroll in participating two-year and four-year public college programs at a reduced tuition level

up to 150% of the institution's regular resident tuition

In all cases, WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition



Tuition Reduction??

OK ... What does THAT mean???

WUE Schools have 3 Tuition Rates!

Resident Tuition
Non-Resident Tuition
WUE Tuition

Resident:

A student who currently resides in the same state as the university they plan to attend.

Non-Resident:

A student who *does not* currently reside in the same state as the university they plan to attend.

Reciprocity:

When a state has agreements with neighboring states to provide lower tuition for residents to attend public colleges and universities in those states. Typically, non-resident admission fees and tuition are reduced (or eliminated) if you're a reciprocity student.

WUE: Western Undergraduate Exchange Tuition Reduction!!

Resident Tuition	\$6,000
Non-Resident Tuition	\$20,000
WUE Tuition (up to 150% of Resident Tuition)	\$9,000 (Save \$44,000 over 4 years!)

These numbers are just an example!

Resident Tuition	\$6,000
Non-Resident Tuition	\$20,000

Financial Aid (Need based)	Must do the FAFSA
Merit Scholarship (Amount varies)	Will stack on top of WUE
WUE Tuition, Fin Aid & Merit Scholarship	\$BIG Money to pay for College

Residency:

Cannot use time on WUE to establish residency


A student receiving WUE is a resident of their home state

& cannot satisfy the time requirement needed to establish residency while receiving WUE



Participating Schools:

EACH College & University sets their Qualifications to get WUE

Not every school has the same qualifications!!

OK there are 84 WUE 4-year Institutions AND Every one Sets their Own Criteria!

Be Admitted

Meet the Qualifications

Apply for the WUE (if necessary)

Qualification & Eligibility:

Financial Qualification??

WUE may be based on family income / need Check with Institution if FAFSA is required

Academic Qualification:

Some colleges and universities have additional criteria such as ACT/SAT test scores or high school GPA.

Each institution determines the qualification and criteria for WUE applicants.

Qualification & Eligibility:

Academic Qualification:

WUE may not be automatically offered or awarded to all eligible candidates

Some WUE schools limit the number of offers Applying EARLY may help

Length of Award:

Most are automatically renewable and capped at 4 years

Many schools have WUE Transfer Programs

Qualification & Eligibility:

What Degree Programs are Eligible??

Some institutions have opened their entire curriculum on a space-available or first-come, first serve basis;

some schools offer only designated programs at the reduced WUE rate.

Admission Requirements

New Freshman:

- Avg. academic GPA 3.6 (weighted)
- Core Courses:
 - English: 4 years
 - Math: 3 years (4 years recommended)
 - Natural Science: 3 years (4 years recommended)
 - Social Science: 3 years

Academic GPA waiver: Core plus 22 ACT or 1120 SAT I (New SAT)



The University of Nevada is also a part of the **WUE** program for <u>incoming freshman</u>, students must:


- -live on campus **AND**

- *there are absolutely no exceptions*






