

1) Credit: Scout does not offer transcripts for Basic or Plus courses, but WASC has authorized Scout to issue transcripts for Premium and On Demand courses.

Students wishing to receive credit for Basic or Plus courses must discuss how credit will be issued with their school counselors before enrolling. The process for getting credit for a Basic or Plus course involves your school adding the Scout course to its a-g list. Then, the course can show up on your high school transcript.
