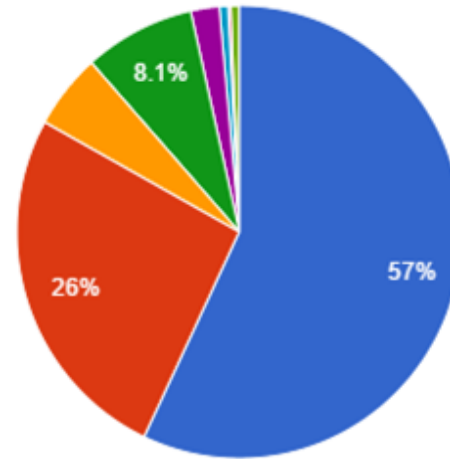

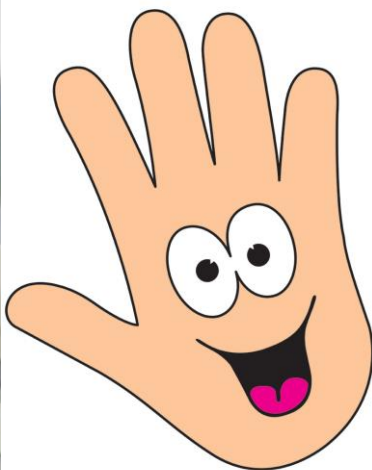




Level of College-Going Culture (CGC) Implementation

0 = What is CGC?



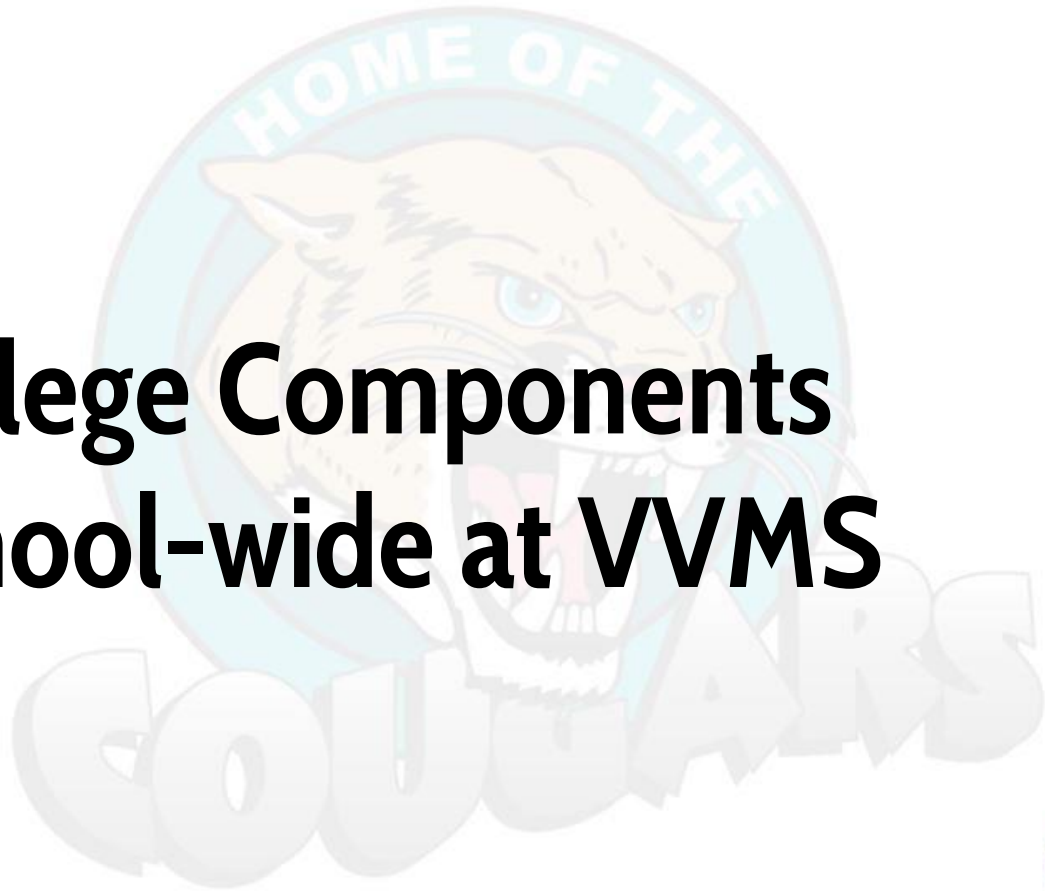
Challenges in MS to create a College-Going Culture
